High Traffic Levels anticipated during week commencing 15th June 2009

Please be advised that during week commencing Monday 15th June the London Heliport anticipates experiencing movement levels above the norm for the time of year due to extra traffic associated with particular sporting events which this year occur in the same week:

Royal Ascot Horse racing event (Tuesday 16th June to Saturday 20th June)

British Formula One Grand Prix at Silverstone (Sunday 21st June).

Please also note that peak periods of demand for Sunday 21st June could start as early as 7.30am as traffic builds, in order that passengers arrive at the Silverstone circuit ready for the start of the race, and resume during the mid- to late-afternoon through until early evening as race goers return from the event.

The London Heliport is actively promoting an enhanced noise abatement policy and is pro-active in publicising this to all operators and aircrew using the facility. Details are available via the "Operations" page of the London Heliport website.
